Self-Made Assignment - Adobe Illustrator

Basic Drawing Tools



1. Create the Donut

- i. using the **Ellipse Tool** while holding Shift to make it perfect.
- ii. **Draw Inner Circle** (for the hole) and center it.
- iii. **Add Frosting:**
- iv. Use the **Pen Tool (P)** to draw a wavy frosting shape covering the top half.
- v. Fill pink color and add sprinkles using small, curved lines in various colors.

2. Create the Trailer

- i. Use the **Rectangle Tool (M)** to draw the base.
- ii. Add angular shapes to give it the look from the image (you can draw these with the Pen Tool or combine rectangles and use the **Shape Builder Tool**).
- iii. Add two small **wheels** using the **Ellipse Tool**, fill with black/white, and group them.
- iv. Place the **donut** on top of the trailer and center it.

3. Draw the Car

- i. Use **rounded rectangles** and **ellipses** for the body.
- ii. The main car shape can be made from a large rounded rectangle.

Basic Drawing Tools

- iii. Use **direct selection tool (A)** to modify anchor points for curves.
- iv. Add **windows** using the Pen Tool or rectangles with curved corners.
- v. Add **wheels** similarly to the trailer.
- vi. Use a solid fill for each part, similar to the orange/red colors in the image.

4. Create Shadows

- i. Use **Ellipse Tool** to make ovals under the car and trailer.
- ii. Fill with a gray color and reduce opacity (~30%) to simulate shadows.

5. Assemble the Scene

- i. Align the trailer behind the car and slightly overlap the hitch.
- ii. Use the **Align Panel** to line everything up horizontally.
- iii. Adjust layering (Object → Arrange → Bring to Front/Back) as needed.

6. Final Touches

- i. Add a **background color** using a rectangle the size of your artboard.
- ii. Check stroke weights and colors for consistency.
- iii. Group each object (car, trailer, donut) for easy movement.
