Self-Made Assignment - Adobe Illustrator

Basic Drawing Tools



1. Set Up Your Artboard

- i. Open Adobe Illustrator.
- ii. Create a new document (e.g., 1080x1080 px).
- iii. Drag and drop your reference image (the one you uploaded) into Illustrator and lock it on a separate layer for tracing.

2. Create the Cup & Steam Design

- i. Cup Shape
- ii. Use the **Ellipse Tool (L)** to make the top of the cup (a horizontal oval).
- iii. Use the **Pen Tool (P)** to draw the body of the cup (trapezoid or curved shape).
- iv. Use the **Ellipse Tool** again to draw the inner liquid.
- v. Use the **Pen Tool** to draw the handle on the right side.
- vi. Combine and adjust shapes using **Pathfinder > Unite** or **Minus Front** as needed.
- vii. Steam Swirl
- viii. Use the **Pen Tool (P)** to manually trace the steam swirl.
- ix. Make sure the curves are smooth – use the **Anchor Point Tool (Shift+C)** to refine.

Self-Made Assignment - Adobe Illustrator

Basic Drawing Tools

x. Apply a white fill with no stroke.

3. Create the Background Circle & Rays

- i. Main Circle
- ii. Use the Ellipse Tool (L) to draw a large dark brown circle behind the cup.
- iii. Sunburst/Rays
- iv. Draw narrow triangle (Pen Tool) from the edge of the circle toward the center.
- v. Duplicate and rotate it around the center.
- vi. Group all rays, place behind the cup, and mask or clip them inside the circle.

4. Add the Text

- i. "Bandrek Kita" Text
- ii. Use the Type Tool (T).
- iii. Select a script font similar to the one used (e.g., Lobster or Pacifico).
- iv. Set the color to orange and apply stroke or shadow using the Appearance Panel.
- v. "SEJAK 1960" Text
- vi. Use a sans-serif font like Montserrat or Arial.
- vii. Place it inside a small banner.
- viii. Use the Pen Tool or Rectangle Tool to create the banner shape, add small ends/flags.

5. Color & Gradient

- i. Use Eyedropper Tool (I) to pick colors from the original image if needed.
- ii. Apply flat colors or subtle gradients to add depth

6. Final Touches

- i. Group all elements (Ctrl+G) and align them properly.
- ii. Add any drop shadows or effects via Effects > Stylize > Drop Shadow.
- iii. Save your file as .AI and export as .PNG or .JPG as needed.
