Accessing & Modifying DOM Elements

Ques 1- Use `getElementsByClassName()` in JavaScript to access and modify a specific HTML element based on its class.

Instructions:

- Create a basic HTML page structure with `<html>`, `<head>`, and `<body>` tags.
- Inside the `<body>`, do the following:
- Add two `<p>` (paragraph) elements.
- Assign both elements the class name "note".
- Give each paragraph different text, such as:
- "Note A"
- "Note B"
- Inside a `<script>` tag (at the end of the body or in the `<head>` using `defer`):
- Use `document.getElementsByClassName("note")` to select all elements with the class "note".
- Access the first element in the returned collection using index 0.
- Change the `textContent` of the first element to:
"Updated Note A"
